Divorce Certificate: (The husband and wife wanting to divorce Islamically)

- Both husband and wife are required to attend
- Wife must not be on her menstrual cycle at time of appointment
- Husband and wife should not have had any intimacy since the wife's last menstrual cycle
- Certification is only issued once the wife has completed the 'iddah period

Applying for Khula': (Application to dissolve Islamic marriage contract)

- Initial assessment interview
- Deciding whether the case will be taken on or not
- If case taken on, husband contacted to be informed of application

- Khula verdict is not a guarantee at end of the process.
